OZARK HIGHLANDS TRAIL and SHEPHERD SPRINGS LOOP TRAIL

PLEASE NOTE:

THE OZARK HIGHLANDS TRAIL IS OVER 175 MILES IN LENGTH AND DOES NOT LOOP BACK TO VISITOR CENTER

- Children should not go on the trail without adult supervision.
- Make sure to leave enough time to return from trail before sunset.
- Take plenty of drinking water. Shepherd Springs is not recommended nor has been tested as potable (drinking) water.

Waterfall/from Visitor Center	.75
Shepherd Springs Loop cut off/from Visitor Center	1
Shepherd Springs springbox/from Visitor Center	1.75
Frog Bayou Creek Crossing/from Visitor Center	2.50
Jack's Creek/from Visitor Center	4.25
Shepherd Springs Loop/ from cut off on OHT to rejoining OHT	1.8
